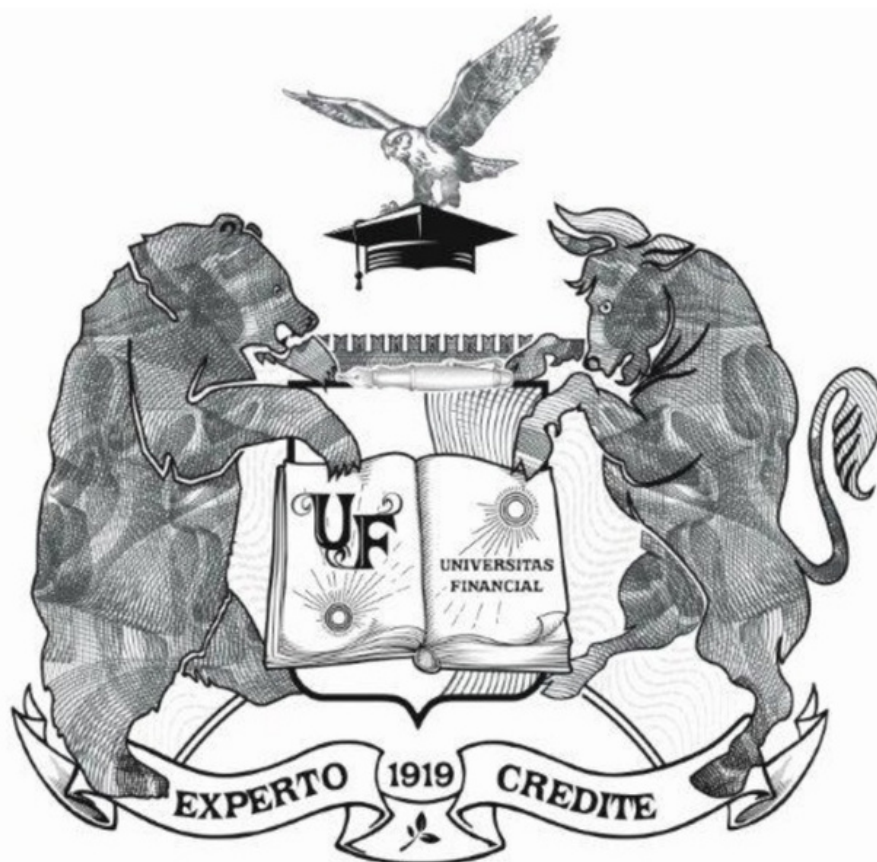

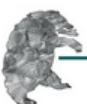

Six finance ministers and many other outstanding persons have graduated from our university.

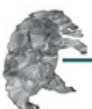
Today our alumnus are leading the largest banks in the country.

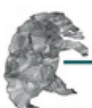

Interesting facts about Russia



The area of Russia is twice larger than the USA and approximately equal to the surface area of Pluto



The Trans-Siberian Railway is the longest railway in the world (9298 km). It is located in 8 time zones, passes through 87 cities and towns and crosses 16 rivers



Russia is famous for coastlines along twelve different seas.



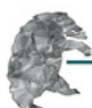
There are 7 absolutely identical high-rise buildings in Moscow. In English, this ensemble is called the «Seven Sisters», and in Russian, simply «Stalin's Skyscrapers». The architectural style of the skyscrapers is called «Stalinist Gothic»



St. Petersburg is the northernmost city in the world with a population of more than a million people



Russia has borders with 16 countries: Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, China, Latvia, Lithuania, Mongolia, Norway, Poland, North Korea, USA, Ukraine, Finland, Estonia and Japan





Transport

Moscow public transport system consist on: buses, trams, trolleybuses, minibuses and a metro

Transport cards

«United»

A travel ticket that is valid for all types of public transport. The cost for 1 trip is 62 RUB, on three days — 540 RUB, 60 trips — 2750 RUB

«Troika»

A refillable electronic card for all types of public transport. The deposit for the card (refundable) is 80 RUB. The fare for the «Troika» is 50 RUB

Metro

Working hours: from 5:30 am to 1:00 am

Buses, trolleybuses, trams

Ground transportation usually works from 5:30 am to 1:00 am. Buses, trolleybuses and trams have specific routes

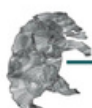


Food

According to official data, the food basket (including bread, pasta, meat, fish, vegetables, fruits, milk, sugar) in Russia costs **4209 rubles per month (~ \$65)**. The average bill for lunch in Moscow cafes and restaurants is **700-2000 rubles (~\$ 11-31)**, a business lunch will cost **230-440 rubles (~\$3.5-7)**.

In fast food restaurants, prices are slightly lower

There are several cafeterias In the buildings of the Financial University. The cost of a set lunch does not exceed **250 rubles**. Additionally, there are canteens in some of the university dormitories





Behavior in the city

1. Always have a copy of your passport, visa and original migration card with you
2. Add your country's embassy number to your mobile phone contact list
3. Beware of pickpockets in crowded places
4. While traveling, be vigilant and monitor your luggage, avoid carrying more than you can comfortably handle
5. Keep your valuables (money, wallet, credit cards, passport) in zippered pockets (on clothes or in a bag)
6. Do not react to verbal offences
7. The police have the right to stop anyone on the street or in the subway to check documents. In case of detention, we recommend contacting the staff of the International Students Office and the Embassy to get support



Leisure

There are many places of interest for tourists in Moscow: The Red Square, the Moscow Kremlin, the St. Basil's Cathedral, the Mausoleum, the GUM, the Alexander Garden, and much more.

In addition, Moscow is famous for its museums.

The largest historical museum of Russia is located on the Red Square. For art lovers, the Tretyakov Gallery and the Museum of Modern Art will be attractive

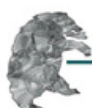

Required documents



Copies of educational documents showing the studied subjects and the grades (points) obtained on them



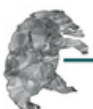
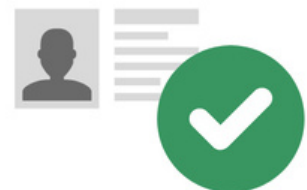
A copy of the medical report on the absence of contraindications for studying in the Russian Federation issued by the official body of the candidate's country of residence (Form No. 086/y)



A copy of the medical certificate on the absence of human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and AIDS disease issued by the official body of the candidate's country of residence (certificate)



The entry study visa requires foreign citizens to present passport pages that are valid for a minimum of 18 months from the start date of their visit to the Russian Federation. Copies of these passport pages should be provided for border crossing purposes



Migration and visa note

On the migration card,
**the purpose of entry
is only «study»!**

Upon arrival in the Russian Federation, it is necessary to register for migration **within 2 working days from the date of arrival.**
Leningradsky prospekt 51/1 (Ленинградский проспект, 51/1), office 0209
Documents: passport, migration card + copies of all passport pages and migration cards

To extend a visa, a foreign student must apply to the Migration and Visa Department (Leningradsky prospekt 51/1 (Ленинградский проспект, 51/1), office 0209) **45 days before the expiration of its validity!**

Within 90 days from the date of entry into the Russian Federation

it is necessary to pass:

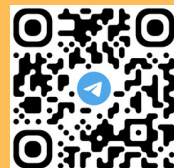
- medical examination (valid for 1 year)
- photographing (the validity period is unlimited)
- fingerprinting (the validity period is unlimited)

Have not left Russia for a year - contact the Migration and Visa Department (Leningradsky prospekt 51/1 (Ленинградский проспект, 51/1), office 0209) 30 days before the expiration of the registration period.

If you checked into a hotel or were being treated in a hospital, **you need to contact the Migration and Visa Department again the next day after your return!**

Foreign citizens need an additional medical insurance policy **for the entire period of stay in the Russian Federation**

Persons under **18** must undergo fingerprinting in the presence of parents, trustees, etc.

For violation of migration and visa legislation, a disciplinary penalty (reprimand) is announced to the student.

After the 3rd reprimand, the student is expelled from the Financial University

From January 1, 2023, foreign citizens and stateless individuals who are enrolled in full-time education programs at Russian state educational institutions of higher education will have the possibility to obtain a temporary residence permit for the purpose of education



To check in to a dormitory, you need to collect a package of documents:



Original passport and copies of all pages



2 photos 3x4 cm



Medical certificate of health status or its copy (form 086/y with mandatory examination by a dermatologist)



Application for the provision of accommodation



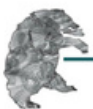
Purchase of additional medical insurance policy



Signing contract to get accommodation in a student dormitory



The students are obliged to pay in advance for accommodation in the dormitory during the holidays if they want to keep their occupied place



Medical support

The additional medical insurance policy is one of the requirements of the university. The policy is needed for:



- migration registration
- processing or extension of a visa
- registration
- accommodation in a dormitory

Online registration

The cost of the policy: from 7,400 rubles / year

Average time of policy registration: 10-15 minutes



Every foreign student **must have medical insurance for the entire period of staying in the Russian Federation**, regardless of the form of study (full-time, part-time, quota-based, or non-quota) and the method of admission (competitive or paid basis)



Passport

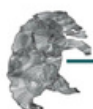
If your passport is lost or is in the Visa Department for extension, you can bring a copy or the certificate that you were given for the period of absence of your passport. Passport translation is not needed



Student card

If you haven't received a student card yet, you may use any other document confirming your enrollment at the university (certificate, contract with the university, etc.)

Other documents (registration, migration card, etc.) are not required for registration of an additional medical insurance policy



Campus card

- ✓ Issued to full-time and part-time students, students of the Preparatory Faculty
- ✓ Serves as a pass to the buildings and dormitories of the Financial University
- ✓ Campus cards for full - time students are given at the Dean's Office of the Faculty

Social card

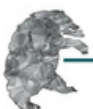
- ✓ Issued to full-time students
- ✓ Serves as a pass to the buildings and dormitories of the Financial University
- ✓ Used as a payment document (scholarship, salary, parking payment, dormitory payment, etc. banking transactions)

How to get a card?

1. With the original passport and its notarized translation, the student will receive the Insurance Number of the Individual Personal Account (СНИЛС) in the Multifunctional Center (МФЦ). The deadline for registration of СНИЛС is 3 working days
2. After receiving the СНИЛС in your personal account on mos.ru leave a request for registration of a social card. The production period of the social card is 1 month
3. After receiving the status of readiness in your personal account on mos.ru pick up a social card at the Multifunctional Center (МФЦ)



Students of the Preparatory Faculty should apply to the address: Leningradsky prospekt 51/1 (**Ленинградский проспект, дом 51/1**), office 0112, with a passport for registration of the campus card



Student's appearance



Regardless of the cultural and religious traditions student's appearance in the Financial University **should comply with the norms of business style**. The clothes also **must exclude provocative details**



Attending classes



The academic year at the Financial University begins on **September 1** and ends according to the working curriculum of a student's program



The duration of the lesson is 1 hour and 30 minutes. The break between classes is at least 10 minutes



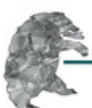
Students are required to attend classes according to the curriculum or individual plan



Students are required to notify the Dean's office in advance about the need to be absent from classes, including exams and tests



Students always must provide the Dean's office with supporting documents that verify the legitimacy of their absence from classes, exams, and tests.



Point-rating system

The Financial University has a **point-rating system**

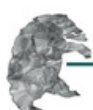
Rating - your place in the general list of students of the faculty

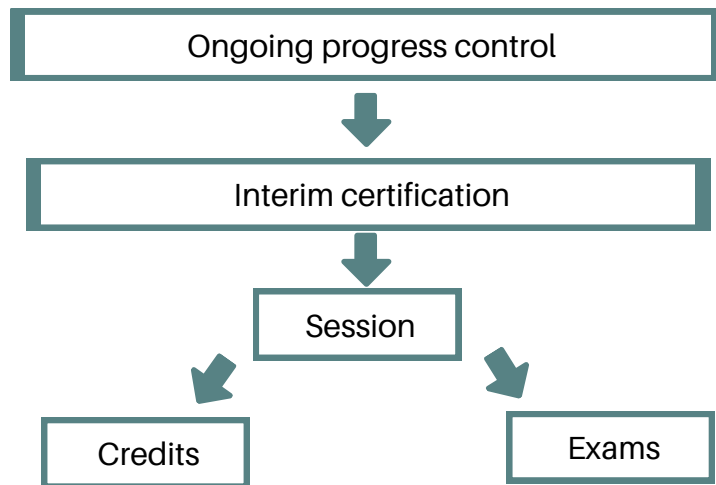
The higher the rating, the more benefits students receive

The teachers announce the scoring criteria to the students on the first lesson of each discipline

Students can earn points by completing tasks during seminars, doing homework, and attending classes

The rating is formed based on the results of the interim assessment for the semester and the session





Ongoing progress control



The main aim of ongoing progress control is to **evaluate the level of knowledge acquisition in subjects throughout the semester**



The first ongoing progress control takes place **from November 1st to 10th and at the end of the semester**

The second ongoing progress control takes place **from April 1st to 10th and at the end of the semester**



Ongoing progress control is conducted **twice per semester, including progress control throughout the academic year**



The minimum score required to pass the ongoing progress control is **7 points**, while the maximum score is **20 points**



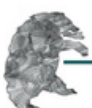
A student who receives a score from 0 to 6 points **is considered to be unqualified. Unqualification in three or more subjects result in a reprimand, and three reprimands lead to expulsion**



The results of ongoing progress control affect the final grade for the test or exam. **The higher the scores in the ongoing progress control, the greater the chances of achieving a positive result**



The results of ongoing progress control evaluation **cannot be used as a reason not to allow a student taking intermediate assessments such as tests and exams**



Interim certification



Interim certification is intended to evaluate midterm and final learning results in particular subjects



Interim certification is carried out in the form of a test, an exam, a course work defense and a practice report



If a student is unable to attend the Interim certification due to a valid reason, the dean of the faculty establishes personal deadlines for the finalisation of the interim certification

Credits



The teacher sets the form of the credit (written / oral)



Credits are taken at the last seminar session



It is possible to receive an indulgence if the total number of points for the interim certification is at least 35 points



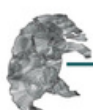
The results of the credit are recorded in the grade sheets as either «accredited» or «not accredited» along with the corresponding score



Students who missed the credit for a valid reason have the right to take the credit before the end of the semester



For this purpose, the teacher announces an additional schedule of his presence in the department



Exams



Exams are conducted:
in writing form for full-time and part-time students
in oral form for part-time students
in oral form in language disciplines



A student who is late for the exam may be allowed to participate, but the end time of the exam remains unchanged



The duration of the written exam is 1 hour and 30 minutes



Before the beginning of the exam, students are free to choose their examination ticket. It is not allowed for the examiner to distribute the examination ticket directly to the students



Students who didn't come to the exam are required to inform the Dean's office about the reasons of their absence. If you can't provide supporting documents of your absence you fail the exam

Academic debt



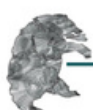
Unsatisfactory results in the interim certification for one or more subjects are considered as academic debt



It is allowed to retake each subject not more than twice



Failing the test or exam on the third attempt (with the participation of a committee) leads to expulsion from the University



The rights of students in the dormitory

Students are required to reside in the assigned room throughout their entire study period, following to the regulations of the dormitory and the terms outlined in the housing contract

Students should contact the dormitory administration to request repairs for equipment that has become damaged without their own fault

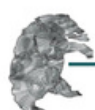
Use the household space, equipment and inventory of the dormitory

Students have the opportunity to take part in the establishment of the dormitory's student council and can be elected as members of the council

Use electrical equipment within fire safety regulations



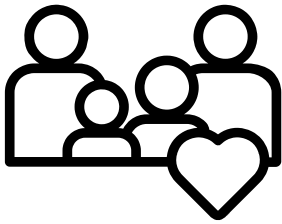

Rules of entrance to dormitory

Access to the dormitory is possible with a personal campus card. It is important that transferring your campus card to someone else can result in serious consequences, including expulsion from the university



Visiting guests

Admission of guests (your close relatives or students of Financial University) to the dormitory is carried out by your written request. Visiting guests must have their passport. Guests can stay in the dormitory from 9:00 to 22:00



Taking in/taking out of oversized items

The delivery of bulky items (electrical devices, furniture, etc.) must be registered by the administrator. The removal of bulky items from the dormitory is allowed if there is a material an approved pass

It is prohibited:



To add extra locks to the room's door



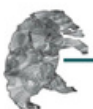
Storing large items confining space in the room



To keep pets in the dormitory



Writing advertisements on the walls of the room, as well as in common areas and other public spaces



In the campus area of the Financial University **it is prohibited:**



Smoking tobacco (including electronic cigarettes and other special devices), as well as inhaling nicotine-containing vapes, including using special devices and devices



Using of drugs and narcotic substances



Drinking alcohol beverages, including low-alcohol, being in a state of alcoholic, narcotic and toxic intoxication



Playing cards and other gambling games



Using swearing expressions



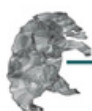
Taking outsiders to the student dormitory and sharing living space with them, including people living in dormitory



Unauthorized relocation of residents and the transfer of furniture from one room to another is not allowed



For violation of fire safety rules, a student can be **ousted from the dormitory and expelled from the Financial University**

«Bridges of Friendship»



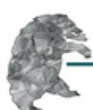

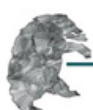
In the cafeterias of the University, you can choose each dish individually to choose from or order a set lunch
